If John Cleese had kids with Lucille Ball, the results might be Bolster and Lee. Annie (The Kransky Sisters) and Clint (HIGH TEA with BOOFF) became creative collaborators in 2004, and with their strong rapport have continued to develop characters to play together ever since. From crazy male duos and siblings of all sorts to mother and son teams and a variety of clowns, these two talents have paired their uniquely funny souls to great effect. Bolster and Lee employ their individual differences in age, height, and sex, to particular advantage; creating characters that are warm and relatable in their endearing nature, yet curiously distinctive in their imposing eccentricities and outlandishly powerful sense of the ridiculous.

He has developed an incredibly reliable and robust local and international network. His unique and innovative creations are represented by over 70 international production houses and arts agencies worldwide and have amassed a live global audience in the millions. He was also recently accepted into the Cirque Du Soleil and Slava Snow Show databases of potential Clowns for future productions and is a proud Queensland Member and Mentor for The Media, Entertainment and Arts Alliance, and Board Member for Indel-Ability Arts.



Annie Lee was born at the foot of a lighthouse in Northern Tasmania and spent her childhood writing poetry and songs and dreaming of travelling afar. For twenty five years Annie Lee has been creating and performing a range of quality shows ranging from large-scalefestival and street theatre works, to cabarets and stage shows including the multi-award winning Kransky Sisters, co-created with fellow performer Christine Johnston. The Kransky Sisters make regular television appearances and tour extensively nationally and internationally. Their awards include, The Melbourne Age Critics Award, Green Room award for Best Cabaret Ensemble, Australian Entertainment Mo Award for Best Comedy Group, Bank of Scotland Herald Angel Award for best comedy show, a Barry Award Nomination, and most recently, a Sydney Theatre Award for Best Comedy Group. Annie is a regular performer with popular Brisbane cabaret series Women In Voice and is best known for her original comedy cabaret shows and 1920s/30s German compilations performed in Germany, England, Ireland, and throughout Australia. Her co-created festival music/comedy acts include Trio Lampooni, Otto Grosso and The Akapainters. She is also creator, producer, and director of unique Arts Queensland

funded festival shows The Perkin Family Freak Show and The Cleavers Family Wreckers. Other original festival creations include, The Welcome Hotel, Freek Street, and the original "Disturbia No. 1 The Village Of Stammore" performed at the Wood ford Folk Festival (Queensland) 2009, Fremantle Arts Festival (Western Australia) and Rockhampton Festival (Queensland). Annie's large scale live installation work, Woolf zingers' Cider Show Alley, was staged at the Huon Valley Mid-Winter Festival, Tasmania in 2016. Her most recent festival comedy creation Bogomila and Son, faux Bulgarian psychic duo, performed at Fremantle International Street Arts Festival 2018, Agnes Waters Music Festival, and The Big Pineapple Music festival Queensland in 2019. Annie has been the recipient of several Arts Queensland & Arts Australia grants for her original productions. In 2014 she was awarded an Arts Queensland grant for her Weimar Cabaret show Dangling My Tootsies, the songs and stories of Agnes Bernelle and the lost poets of Weimar. The work was staged under its new title Lighthouse Berlin. at the Cremorne Theatre Queensland Performing Arts Centre, Chapel Off Chapel, Melbourne Cabaret Festival June 2015 & Festival of Jewish Arts & Music Melbourne 2017. Her most recent solo production, autobiographical one-woman show, Pawn Again Christian was staged at the Butterfly Club Melbourne in 2018.



Josh Mcintosh is an award-winning designer whose work has been seen on stages across Australia. Josh has worked extensively with major Queensland cultural organisations including Queensland Performing Arts Centre, Queensland Ballet, Opera Queensland and Queensland Theatre Company. His design skills are augmented by his strong grounding as a builder, maker and engineer. He has designed several successful national touring productions including stage adaptations of A Christmas Carol and Animal Farm for Shake & Stir. THREE COMPANY MEMBERS TOUR WITH THE SHOW

2x Clown Performer

1x Technical/Stage Manager

FEE.

Company fee can be advised upon request and will be dependent on the duration and location of the proposed presentation.

PERFORMANCE SCHEDULE

Presenters have some flexibility as to how show times are scheduled depending on other venue and festival activities. The optimal performance duration of BOLSTER & LEE is 3 Hours. The company requires a 20 - 25 minute break time.

VISAS.

Presenter to arrange and pay for company visas and travel insurances.

TRAVEL & FLIGHTS

Presenter to provide. For international flights, premium economy seats are required for ClintBolster due to his height of 197cm. For domestic Australian flights, additional leg room seats in economy are required - e.g. Virgin Blue Economy X - Row 3. Standard non exit row economy seats for domestic Australian flights are not sufficient for Clint. Standard economy seats are fine for other company members.



ACCOMMODATION

Presenter to provide. Minimum 3.5-star accommodation for all company members. Company members should be housed in seperate apartments; accommodation must include kitchen and laundry facilities - located ideally within 2km or 15 minute walk to the venue.

DRESSING ROOMS

One secure dressing room is required for the duration all show calls. The room must have a full size wardrobe mirror and a make-up mirror with ample lighting. Either in-theatre laundry or accommodation-based laundry facilities are required for all bookings.

CALL TIMES

A minimum 1.5 hour hair & make-up call is required for any BOLSTER & LEE performance, media call, promotional booking or other event.



MARQUEE DIMENSIONS.

Detailed production venue technical specifications, insurances and engineering certificates can be provided upon request.

BUMP-IN OVERVIEW

The company production manager MUST be present onsite when the truck arrives for site installation. A minimum of 16 hours is required between company/unit arrival & first performance. An exact bump-in schedule will be drafted with presenters on a case-by-case basis.

CARNET

Touring party to provide

SITE LOCATION.

The minimum floor area required for the unit is 8m x 7m. The site area must be flat, stable ground. The site area can not be at risk of flooding in the event of rain. An egress corridor of 1.2m must be maintained 360° around the unit for technical access. The front of the venue where theaudience enter requires 3m clear egress for front of house elements such as signage and accessibility ramp. Unless agreed by the company, the venue can not be directly abutted to another structure.

WEATHER

The venue can not operate in wind speeds higher than 60km/h. If heavy rain or storms are forecast, the venue may have to close for the duration of the weather event OR, in lighter rain - a wet weather contingency performance format is initiated.



FREIGHT.

Presenter to arrange and pay. The Production tours out of Brisbane, Queensland unless otherwise advised. The Company logistics partner is Roadpro Event Services based in Archefield, Qld and presenters can be put in touch with RoadPro for freight movements within Australia.

STORAGE

Presenter to supply adequate and safe storage facilities for all road cases - which will be detailed upon request.

SECURITY.

Presenter to provide 24 hour security throughout the period that the venue is onsite.



SITE (PRESENTER TO SUPPLY)

- Minimum 8m x 6m area for venue setup Flat, stable ground not susceptible to flooding or subsidence.
- 1 x 3m Ladder (A-Frame or platform).
- Covid QR sign in signage as required by local authorities.
- Access for 8tone back loader truck onto the site can provide detailed Carnet of all equipment with dimensions and weights - e.g.
- Travel Cases & Set items etc.
- Access to a forklift & driver for up to 1 hour to lift marquee travel case into place
 + 4 x 300kg cement blocks.
- We also require a Pallet Jack on site.
- All site approvals, site protection measures (truck matting) & site restoration.



POWER (PRESENTER TO SUPPLY).

- 2 x 15 amp circuits on a distroboard or equivalent
- Our preference for power is a distribution board located within our 12m x 12m area allocated for our venue.
- Please note, that our distribution board or equivalent will need to be used solely by Bolster & Lee and not shared with anyone else.

CREW REQUIREMENTS (PRESENTER TO SUPPLY)

5 x Mechs for 5 Hour Bump In and 5 x Mechs for 5 Hour Bump Out

VENUE SAFETY REQUIREMENTS

The venue can operate in wind speeds of up to 55km/hr B22- if forecast weather conditions exceed this wind speed - and the venue is outdoors - the company will need to dismount roofing signage elements and the presenter will need to provide GET-OUT level technical support for this to happen. Once the weather event has passed, the presenter will need to provide GET-IN levels of support to re-open the venue.B23
